 - 1) Provide more trim detail to the columns. Wrap the column bases up to a 4 to 6 inch height above the horizontal rail cap and trim out the top of the columns below the beam to provide a column cap. Overall intent is to mimic the original columns that were removed as shown in the photos.
 - 2) The current rail is too thin. Provide horizontal trim below the horizontal rail cap on both sides of the balusters under the rail cap or provide a thicker horizontal rail cap to mimic the original rail that was shown in the photos. The current rail profile design is too thin and does not blend in with the original detailing of the structure.
