

REGULAR MEETING
CUDAHY POLICE AND FIRE COMMISSION
June 11, 2014

President Thomas Kujawa called the meeting to order at 5:44 p.m. in Conference Room A of the Cudahy City Hall, Cudahy, Wisconsin. Commissioners Thomas Kujawa, Kathryn Wojtysiak, Victor Venus, Gerald Rieder and Donald Mulock were present. Chief of Police Thomas Poellot, Fire Chief Daniel Mayer and Recording Secretary Jaci Duvall were also present.

President Kujawa read the open meeting law statement.

A motion was made by Commissioner Wojtysiak and seconded by Commissioner Rieder to accept the minutes of the meeting minutes of April 10, April 29, May 3, May 4 and May 8, 2014, as typewritten. All Commissioners voted in favor. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS

FIRE DEPARTMENT

Chief Mayer presented the Fire Department reports for April and May 2014. April's Ropes and Knots training was a prelude for the month of May's Lake Bank Rescue training. Driver Operator Pumper (basic fire engine) training also took place in April along with Annual SCBA Evaluation and EMS Narcan training. The last half of May was devoted to hose testing where hoses are filled beyond the water pressure used at a fire scene to ensure the equipment is working properly.

As a thank you from the family of an elderly resident who needed medical attention, the Fire Department received a donation of a Knox box.

During an awards ceremony at Aurora St. Luke's Medical Center, Firefighter/EMTs Joe Fremy, Brandon Specht and Matt Kolosovsky were recognized for their teamwork and great saves in three separate incidents of saving pulseless, non-breathing patients.

FF/EMT Jared Kucik will be sworn in on Friday.

POLICE DEPARTMENT

Chief Poellot presented the Police Department reports through May 2014. Chief Poellot will continue to share Department training, equipment purchases and highlights with the Commission.

The Commission was given a visual representation of the retirements and new hires/promotions for 2014. Three new officers will be starting at the end of June pending successful completion of medical and drug testing and psychological assessment.

Commissioner Mulock was excused at 6:43 p.m.
