

SPECIAL MEETING
CUDAHY POLICE AND FIRE COMMISSION
September 25, 2014

President Thomas Kujawa called the meeting to order at 3:02 p.m. in Conference Room A of the Cudahy City Hall, Cudahy, Wisconsin. Commissioners Thomas Kujawa, Victor Venus, Gerald Rieder and Donald Mulock were present. Commissioner Kathryn Wojtysiak was present for part of the meeting. Chief of Police Thomas Poellot and Recording Secretary Jaci Duvall were also present.

President Kujawa read the open meeting law statement.

CLOSED SESSION

At 3:03 p.m., Commissioner Rieder made a motion to enter into closed session according to State Statute 19.85(1)(c) Personnel Matters – Interview candidates for Police Department Promotions for the positions of Detective, Sergeant, Lieutenant and Captain. Commissioner Mulock seconded the motion. All Commissioners voted in favor. Motion carried.

OPEN SESSION

At 5:17 p.m., Commissioner Mulock made a motion to enter into open session; Commissioner Venus seconded the motion. All Commissioners voted in favor. Motion carried.

ACTION TAKEN ON CLOSED SESSION

Commissioner Mulock made a motion to waive the goodness of fit evaluations and to approve the appointments of

Lieutenant Dala Milosavljevic to the position of Captain pending successful completion of a one-year probationary period;

Sergeant Christopher Blunt to the position of Lieutenant pending successful completion of a one-year probationary period;

Detective Joseph Zblewski to the position of Sergeant pending successful completion of a one-year probationary period;

Corporal Craig Bultman to the position of Patrol Sergeant pending successful completion of a one-year probationary period, successful completion of a school of Basic Police Supervision within one year of promotion and successful completion of Northwestern University Center for Public Safety School of Police Staff and Command ten (10) week training program when the Chief of Police determines it is administratively and fiscally practical to do so; and

Police Officer Andrew Ayala to the position of Detective pending successful completion of a one-year probationary period, successful completion of a school of Basic Police Supervision within one year of promotion and successful completion of Northwestern University Center for Public Safety School of Police Staff and Command ten (10) week training program when the Chief of Police determines it is administratively and fiscally practical to do so.

It is noted that Lieutenant Milosavljevic, Sergeant Blunt and Detective Joseph Zblewski have successfully completed Northwestern University Center for Public Safety School of Police Staff and Command and a school of Basic Police Supervision.

Commissioner Venus seconded the motion. All Commissioners voted in favor. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Mulock to adjourn at 5:18 p.m. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Rieder. All Commissioners voted in favor. Motion carried.
