

REGULAR MEETING
CUDAHY POLICE AND FIRE COMMISSION
February 11, 2016

Commissioner Kathryn Wojtysiak called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. in Conference Room A of the Cudahy City Hall, Cudahy, Wisconsin. Commissioners Gerald Rieder, Don Mulock and Vera Trifunovich were present. Fire Chief Dan Mayer, Police Chief Thomas Poellot and Recording Secretary Jill Santi were also present. FIRE DEPARTMENT

Fire Chief Mayer advised the Commission of various training exercises that were done in the month of January which included in service at Ladish (ATI) and Ice Rescue. Chief Mayer also advised of shift changes for the 24 firefighters and their new responsibilities. An update on the condo fire, a thank you note and the number of calls (runs) by the fire department. Chief Mayer was excused at 6:10 pm.

POLICE DEPARTMENT

Police Chief Poellot advised the commissioners the police department responded to 300 more calls for service in January 2016 than in 2015. A total of six death investigations and 2 homicides were some of the reports taken this January. Chief also advised there is one officer on light duty until June and Officer Daniel Markus resigned from the force as of January 27th, 2016.
