

REGULAR MEETING
CUDAHY POLICE AND FIRE COMMISSION
March 10, 2016

Commissioner Thomas Kujawa called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. in Conference Room A of the Cudahy City Hall, Cudahy, Wisconsin. Commissioners Kathryn Wojtysiak, Gerald Rieder, and Vera Trifunovich were present. Fire Chief Dan Mayer, Police Chief Thomas Poellot and Recording Secretary Jill Santi were also present. Commissioner Donald Mulock was absent.

A motion was made by Commissioner Trifunovich and seconded by Commissioner Rieder to accept the meeting minutes of February 11, 2016. All Commissioners voted in favor. Motion carried.

Police Chief Poellot asked that we enter into closed session first and the PFC members agreed.

CLOSED SESSION

At 5:35 p.m., Commissioner Wojtysiak made a motion to enter into closed session according to State Statute 19.85(1)(b) Personnel Matter – Police Department. Commissioner Trifunovich seconded the motion. All Commissioners voted in favor. Motion carried.

OPEN SESSION

At 6:45 p.m., Commissioner Wojtysiak made a motion to enter into open session; Commissioner Trifunovich seconded the motion. All Commissioners voted in favor. Motion carried.

ACTION TAKEN ON CLOSED SESSION

A motion to approve the successful completion of Daniel Gerlitz's probationary period was made by Commissioner Wojtysiak and seconded by Commissioner Trifunovich. All in favor. Motion carried.

A motion to accept the voluntary demotion from Captain Dala Milosavljevic to Lieutenant was made by Commissioner Wojtysiak and seconded by Commissioner Trifunovich. All in favor. Motion carried. Commissioner Rieder abstained from voting.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

Fire Chief Mayer advised the Commission of various training exercises that were done in the month of February which included ropes and knots, Firefighter survival techniques and flashover, and EMT recertification. Jared P Kucik received a certificate from Gateway Technical College for Paramedic Transition Refresher, a thank you note from the Hoenig family and the number of calls (runs) by the fire department. Chief Mayer was excused at 6:50 pm.

POLICE DEPARTMENT

Police Chief Poellot advised the Commission of various calls the police department responded to in February including two search warrants, suspicious vehicles at a nuisance property, and an officer being struck by a passing motorist while assisting another officer with a traffic stop. Also advised the officer applicants were taking the Wisconsin Personnel Partners test on Saturday, March 12 and should receive the results before the next PFC meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

Handed out a copy of the questions for the PFC members regarding the upcoming police applicant interviews to take with them and see if they want any changes. We will discuss any changes, if necessary, at next meeting.

The next PFC meeting will be set for Thursday, April 14th, 2016.
