

## Drop Off Site Information

### 2016 Drop Off Site Changes

Effective October 2015, the Drop Off Site will no longer accept any vehicle larger than a pick up with a 6.5' bed or a trailer larger than 4' x 8'. No vehicle/trailer combinations will be allowed. Use of U-Haul's will not be allowed. For any major home remodels, spring cleaning or projects coming up, consider renting a dumpster for easy disposal of all your items.

### Special Pickups

The City of Cudahy does not provide any special pickups. A special pickup for disposal may be requested for a fee through Advanced Disposal. Please call (262) 679-0860 for more information or to arrange a special pickup.

### Freon-Containing Appliances

The City Drop Off Site accepts Freon-Containing Appliances free of charge during normal drop off site business hours. Freon-Containing Appliances include appliances such as air conditioners, refrigerators and freezers. Other items accepted include stoves, ovens, dishwashers, microwaves and more.

If you cannot bring your items to the City drop off site, Refrigerant Depot accepts drop offs for free at their facility located at 5311 S. 9th St., Milwaukee, WI 53221. Please call Refrigerant Depot at (414) 627-1152 for more information.

### Hazardous Waste

Household Hazardous waste must be taken to MMSD. Their closest location is 10518 S. 124th Street, Franklin, WI. The Drop-off Site only accepts eWaste two times per year. Monitors & TVs will be accepted for \$20 apiece, any other eWaste is accepted free of charge at these times only.

### Holiday Tree Disposal

Holiday Tree Disposal begins Monday January 4, 2016 and goes through Wednesday, January 20, 2016.

Trees will be collected at the front curb only. Please ensure trees are not buried in snow banks and will be visible for crews. Remove lights, tinsel and other items as the tree gets chipped. Wreaths & garland may be placed in your garbage cart.

### Holiday Recyclable Disposal

Cudahy's garbage service is automated, so extra garbage generated from the holidays will not be picked up if it is stacked on top of, or next to, your garbage cart.

The Drop Off Site will only be open one day during the winter, **January 2, 2016** from 8:30 a.m.—12:30 p.m. to accept extra trash and recyclables. Bags of garbage and recycling will be the only items accepted on this day.

DID YOU  
 KNOW?

The price tag of The City's Spring Cleanup is \$102,000 annually.

The recycling cart fee has not increased since 2007, however the cost of recycling collection has increased 9% in that time.

The State of Wisconsin cut \$40,000 from the City's recycling grant.

In 2015, improper items set out for Spring Cleanup cost the City \$10,100 to dispose of.

## Spring Cleanup Alternative

Beginning January 1, 2016, in lieu of Spring curbside pickup, the City will issue two free drop-off site passes to each Cudahy property owner that pays a recycling cart fee. These passes can be used to dispose of acceptable rubbish or yard waste at the City's Drop off Site in 2016. Each pass is good for one trip into the facility. The maximum amount per trip is a pick up truck with a maximum bed size of 6.5' or a 4'x8' trailer.

Drop off tickets will be available to the owner of the property for pickup at City Hall during normal City Hall hours (after January 1, 2016). You will be required to show an ID, which must match the address that includes the recycling cart fee on your property tax bill. **Passes will not be available at the drop off site.**

### Don't my taxes fund these services?

Spring Cleanup is funded solely by the recycling cart charge on the property tax bill. The fee (\$66/cart) also pays for the pick-up and processing of recycling material and leaf collection.

### My taxes keep increasing while DPW services decrease. Why?

Services have been cut due to shifting of funds from DPW to public safety.
