Kirkwood Avenue, Barnard Avenue Extended

OWNER/TIME: The City of Cudahy is soliciting bids for reconstruction of Kirkwood Avenue from Grange to 1200' n/o Grange and new construction of Barnard Avenue extended to Nicholson Avenue. Both projects have been designed to be completed by November 2016. An alternate has been included to use concrete pavement on Barnard Avenue Extended. Sealed bids will be received by the City of Cudahy, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, until **10:00 a.m. Monday, March 28, 2016** at the City of Cudahy, City Hall, 5050 So. Lake Drive, P.O. Box 100510, Cudahy, Wisconsin 53110. Bid proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud at the above time and place. Each bid proposal must be submitted on the bid/proposal form provided in the Contract Documents and shall be enclosed in a sealed envelope addressed to the City of Cudahy and marked "Bid" with the project name.

This project consists of the full reconstruction of an existing asphalt roadway with subgrade issues. The second roadway is new construction. Approximate quantities consist of:

Lake Dr.) or digitally through the City "Drop-Box" by calling (414) 769-2212 starting **Monday, March 14th, 2016** between the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m, Monday through Friday. The Contract Documents are available for free. All bidders shall bid in accordance with, and shall bid upon the forms provided.

STATUTORY PROVISIONS: The contract letting shall be subject to the provisions of the Wisconsin Statutes, including Section 61.55, 61.56, 62.15, 66.29, 66.293, 779.14 and 779.16. Minimum wage scales to be paid on the project shall be in accordance with the prevailing wage rates per the Department of Workforce Development.

BID GUARANTEE: No bid will be received unless a certified check or bank draft payable to the City of Cudahy, or a satisfactory bid bond in an amount no less than five percent (5%) of the bid, shall accompany each bid as a guarantee that if the bid is accepted, the bidder will execute and file the Agreement and a 100% performance bond and payment bond, within ten (10) days after the

Notice of Award. In case the bidder fails to file such contract and bond within the time set forth, the check or bid bond shall be forfeited to the City of Cudahy as liquidated damages.

BID WITHDRAWAL: No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) days after the bid opening date without the consent of the City of Cudahy.

BID REJECTION: The City of Cudahy reserves the right to accept any bid most advantageous to the City, waive any technicality or reject any or all bids.
