

2017 PROJECTS

PACKARD NORTH ROAD PROJECT

- Packard Avenue will be fully reconstructed between Cudahy and Lunham Avenue

GRANGE AVE SEWER & WATER EXT.

- Sewer & Water Services are being extended west on Grange Avenue for the 128th Air Refueling Wing.

HAZARDOUS SIDEWALK PROJECT

- Hazardous sidewalks that were marked will be replaced in the city north of Layton between the blocks of Swift and Lake Dr. This work is carried over from 2016.

PARKING LOT & PLAZA UPGRADES

- With DNR grant money, the public parking lot at Squire and the Plaza at Layton & Packard will be reconstructed using porous pavers for storm water quality.

STORM WATER ALLEY IMPROVEMENT

- Another development at Squire & Layton requires the replacement of the alley at 3500 Layton. This project will utilize a new storm water friendly alley construction style with porous pavers down the center.

CDBG BUS STOP IMPROVEMENTS

- Bus stop locations along Pennsylvania Avenue will be improved with a concrete pad for sitting/standing using Community Development Block Grant Funds.

HAZARDOUS TREE REMOVAL

- The City has hired a contractor to remove the compromised throughout the City

CITY HALL ROOF/ADA CONSTRUCTION

- The second phase of the City Hall roof replacement project will be completed this year. In addition, all of the entry ways into the City Hall Building will be reconstructed to meet ADA standards.
