

**MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF CANVASS OF THE CITY OF CUDAHY HELD MONDAY,  
 APRIL 13, 2015 FOR THE CANVASS OF LATE ARRIVING ABSENTEE BALLOTS AND  
 CUDAHY SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF CANVASS  
 FROM THE APRIL 7, 2015 SPRING ELECTION**

**ROLL CALL**

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 A.M. by Deputy City Clerk Toms-Neary. Present were canvassers Dennis Broderick, Darlene Felton and John Hohenfeldt. Also in attendance: Clerk Sobieski. Members present for the School District Canvass: Karen Weber, James Papala and Mary Rejniak.

**OPEN MEETING STATEMENT**

Proper open meeting statement was read.

**New Business**

1. Canvass of the late arriving absentee ballots from the April 7, 2015 election. Wards 1,2,3,6,7,8, 12 and 14 were canvassed with a total of twelve (12) late received absentee ballots postmarked no later than April 7, 2015, Election Day.

Wards 1-2-3 had a total of 6 certificates with 0 rejected.  
 Ward 6 had a total of 1 certificate with 0 rejected.  
 Ward 7 had a total of 2 certificates with 1 rejected.  
 Ward 12 had a total of 1 certificate with 0 rejected.  
 Ward 14 had a total of 2 certificates with 0 rejected.

Of the 12 certificates received, 1 was rejected for lack of voter and witness signatures. The 11 good certificates were checked against the original poll listings making sure nobody voted on Election Day. All good certificates were given a voter number and recorded on the absentee log. They were then opened, with ballots going into privacy container, certificates going into the voted certificate envelope and rejected certificates into the rejected ballot envelope. Votes were read and recorded by reporting unit on tally sheets. Reporting unit totals were then tallied for city-wide tally sheet.

Eleven ballots were cast with 71 votes for individual candidates and referendum.
