




PACKARD AVENUE UTILITY CONSTRUCTION TO BEGIN SOON

The sewer and water replacement on Packard Avenue is expected to begin sometime the week of September 12th. Although property owners on Packard Avenue have received information about the project, we are also including property owners within a block of the project to get them better acquainted with the road closures, parking, and the detour route. This is typical for projects of this magnitude and is what we have done for previous projects such as the downtown reconstruction. The City met with the Contractor in order to finalize the schedule and coordinate efforts with the School District and Milwaukee County Transit. The following summarizes the information we obtained at the meeting.



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- **Monday, September 12th, 2016** the contractor plans to start work on Packard Ave. They will first install the traffic control, detour route and mobilize equipment and material to the jobsite. The Contractor will then begin on the Sanitary Sewer relay between Allerton and Cudahy Avenue. This area will be the first phase of the project. The Contractor will then proceed to the second phase located between Allerton and Lunham Ave.
 - **The primary detour route will be on Kingan Avenue from Plankinton to Lunham.** All traffic including local bus routes will run down this road. Temporary signs for bus routes and bus stop locations will be posted accordingly.
 - **Allerton Avenue** - The East and West directions of traffic shall remain open across Packard Avenue for Lincoln Elementary School Pickup and drop-off. There is some water main and storm sewer that needs to be replaced within the intersection that will require the temporary closure of the intersection. This work is scheduled to take place after school hours or during days where school is not in service. Anytime work is scheduled within this intersection, the school district will be notified so that they can inform parents and staff.
 - **Alleys are not meant to be used as detour routes.** Local traffic shall follow the posted detour routes along the side streets. The alleys are to be used only as access for property owners that live along the alley and not as a main thoroughfare.
 - **Residents living one block East and West** - Your services are not being reconstructed and your road will remain open. You will not be able to access Packard Avenue but the alleys will remain open. Your water service may temporarily be interrupted for water main reconnections from the old pipe to the new pipe. Work normally takes 4-6 hours to make reconnections. A 24 hour minimum notice will be provided should this occur.
 - **NO PARKING will be in effect on Packard Ave.** within the construction zones, including the detour route, and some of the adjacent side streets. The entirety of the road will be closed off.
 - **Driveway Access & Permits** - Those with driveways on Packard will have to park on the side streets to reach their home. These property owners will be given parking passes with this letter in order to park overnight on the side streets.
 - **Night time parking permit holders for Packard Ave. are directed to park on adjacent side streets as close to Packard Ave. as possible.** They must be legally parked, and must park in areas without posted no-parking signs. Police department odd/even night parking restrictions still apply for surrounding blocks, unless noted otherwise.

- **S. Kingan Ave. from E. Plankinton Ave. to E. Lunham Ave. will be posted NO PARKING along both sides of the street.** This street will be a dedicated detour route for duration of the project which necessitates a wider roadway width, therefore parking cannot be accommodated. The Residents that park on these blocks, shall use nearby blocks for overflow parking. Police department odd/even night parking restrictions still apply for surrounding blocks, unless noted otherwise.
- **We Energies work** - The work being completed for the gas company shall be finished around the same time as the sewer and water contractor begins installing the traffic control. The work may overlap but it will not affect the construction schedule.

- **Sewer & Water Work** - When multiple utilities are reconstructed it seems like there is a lot of jumping around. This is intentional because the Contractor starts with the relay of the sanitary sewer, then the water main, and finally the storm sewer. After all of the main line work is complete, the Contractor will come back and install the private laterals to the properties.
