To: City of Cudahy Residents

The Cudahy Police Department is releasing the following information pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 301.46(2m) which allows law enforcement agencies to notify the public that a sex offender is living in the community. This notification is not intended to heighten fear; rather, it is intended to increase your awareness of this person's presence in the community.

Cudahy Municipal Ordinance Chapter 28 Article II prohibits certain sex offenders from residing in the City of Cudahy, and prevents some offenders from residing within 500 feet from real property enumerated within the Chapter, unless the offender meets a certain domicile exemption. The sections within Chapter 28 also restrict sex offenders from being present within designated Child Safety Zones, as listed in Chapter 28.

The subject of this notification is David J Punzel, 38 years of age. Punzel was convicted of 3rd Degree Sexual Assault on December 16, 2011. Because Punzel was a resident of the City of Cudahy at the time of his conviction, he is allowed to return to the city upon his release from incarceration. The release date is scheduled for June 19, 2018.



Punzel will remain on Extended Supervision by the Wisconsin Department of Corrections until June 22, 2020. The conditions of his supervision include GPS monitoring, compliance of standard sex offender rules, no unsupervised contact with minors, no contact with the victim, no presence at taverns-bars-liquor stores, and no alcohol or drug use.

Punzel will be residing at 3833 E Hammond Ave, Cudahy, WI 53110.

Punzel is not currently wanted by the police for any criminal offenses. He must conform to all the rules and regulations as imposed by his probation agent, as well as the City of Cudahy Sexual Offender Ordinance.
