OWNER/TIME: The City of Cudahy is soliciting bids for reconstruction of multiple roadways. This includes the full reconstruction of Eaton/Merrill as well as the reconstruction of the driving lanes on Barland Ave. and the Cudahy Middle School intersection improvements. Both portions of the project have been designed to be completed by fall of 2015. An alternate has been included to complete the project using asphalt pavement. Sealed bids will be received by the City of Cudahy, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, **until 10:00 a.m. Friday, March 6, 2015** at the City of Cudahy, City Hall, 5050 So. Lake Drive, P.O. Box 100510, Cudahy, Wisconsin 53110. Bid proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud at the above time and place. Each bid proposal must be submitted on the bid/proposal form provided in the Contract Documents and shall be enclosed in a sealed envelope addressed to the City of Cudahy and marked "Bid" with the project name.

This project consists of the full reconstruction of two roadways and one intersection within the City of Cudahy. The project can be completed with concrete or with the combination of concrete and asphalt as shown with the alternate bid. All storm sewer work has been completed prior to construction and all handicap ramps and driveway aprons will need to be reconstructed. Approximate quantities consist of:

Contract Documents may be obtained from the City of Cudahy Engineering Office, City Hall, (5050 So. Lake Dr. Telephone 414-769-2212) starting **Monday, February 23, 2015** between the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The Contract Documents are available for free using the City's Dropbox site or can be sent digitally by calling the aforementioned phone number. If the documents are to be sent by mail, the City needs to receive a check for \$10.00 per set before they will be mailed out. Request by mail shall be made by Friday, February 27, 2015. All bidders shall bid in accordance with, and shall bid upon the forms provided.

STATUTORY PROVISIONS: The contract letting shall be subject to the provisions of the Wisconsin Statutes, including Section 61.55, 61.56, 62.15, 66.29, 66.293, 779.14 and 779.16. Minimum wage scales to be paid on the project shall be in accordance with the prevailing wage rates per the Department of Workforce Development.

BID GUARANTEE: No bid will be received unless a certified check or bank draft payable to the City of Cudahy, or a satisfactory bid bond in an amount no less than five percent (5%) of the bid, shall accompany each bid as a guarantee that if the bid is accepted, the bidder will execute and file the Agreement and a 100% performance bond and payment bond, within ten (10) days after the Notice of Award. In case the bidder fails to file such contract and bond within the time set forth, the check or bid bond shall be forfeited to the City of Cudahy as liquidated damages.

BID WITHDRAWAL: No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) days after the bid opening date without the consent of the City of Cudahy.

BID REJECTION: The City of Cudahy reserves the right to accept any bid most advantageous to the City, waive any technicality or reject any or all bids.
