
We spoke with Milo Basina, Owner

When did you become the owner of Orson's Saloon?

MB: I became owner in September of 2014.

What led you to become the owner?

MB: I liked the building because of its historic character. The age of the building was an asset. I made renovations when I bought the place, but I also wanted to keep the unique character intact.

Orson's used to be called Pinter's Inn. It was built in 1908 as an electrical shop. Later it became a tavern.

Do you sponsor activities or events?

Recently we sponsored Sip and Taste, an event for a community seniors' group. There are raffles for charities, a pool league, open mic nights, and I'd like to sponsor a softball team. More can be found on our website. We sponsor a lot of community based efforts.

It seems like you are quite involved in community building activities.

A goal of mine is to change the black cloud image of the taverns in Cudahy into something positive by being involved in the community and giving back. A part from that we want to attract new revenue into Cudahy for entertainment. We also want to keep the people from Cudahy who go to Bayview for their entertainment in Cudahy.

Do you serve food?

We will begin serving food in the near future. That is one of my goals.

What are your hours of operation?

We are only closed on Sundays and Mondays, except for Packer games. We may start to be open for Brewer games on those days depending on business.
