
We spoke with Zaul Zaul, Store Owner

I have only been here five minutes on a Thursday at 5 pm and already five customers have entered. Is this your usual busy hour, after work?

What led you to begin this business?

I've been a resident of Cudahy for the past 10 years and thought of the idea from desiring a local, easily accessible convenience store to pick up a few items, without going into a large grocery store. This is the first business I've owned.

Why did you chose this location in Cudahy?

I met with the Mayor Hohenfeldt and Alderman Moralez, told them my idea, and they gave me a few location possibilities. This space was a former photography studio that I remodeled. It was in my price range and a centralized location.

Do you have plans to expand or add to the store?

My goal is to create a deli with the space I have in back of the store. Remodeling the store cost more than expected, so a deli will become more possible as I'm able to pay the rest off first. *laughs*

How do you advertise?

Local ad books such as Bargain Hunter.

How many employees do you have?

There is one other full-time employee. My family helps me out a lot. My kids are 19 and 20 years old, so they help.



What are your hours of operation?

We are open 9 am to 9 pm, 7 days of the week.

What should people know about your business, or what makes the store different?

We are friendly and the owner gets to know our customers. Prices are reasonable and we have deals from time to time.
