
We spoke with Kris Griffith, Co-Owner/Operator

When did you open and why at this location?

KG: My husband Randy Griffith opened the business at this location in 1987. For a couple years prior he operated a mobile locksmith service. He lived in St. Francis at the time and decided to rent this shop. It had been a previous locksmith's business. We purchased the building in 2005.

What type of services do you provide?

We are a full service locksmith providing keys, replacement keys, lock installation, lock-out service. We also create storefront signs and banners and engraved plaques.
