**Road Reconstruction  
Kirkwood Avenue - Morris Ave. to Grange Ave.**

**What will the Project Involve?** The proposed road project will entail the reconstruction of the roadway of S. Kirkwood Ave. from 500' north of Mallory Avenue south to E. Grange Ave. The work will involve the removal & replacement of pavement, curb, driveway aprons and sidewalk. The storm sewer inlets will also be removed and replaced. The current pavement in this area is beyond its life cycle and needs to be reconstructed. There are very poor soils so it has been a complicated engineering matter for many years. The side streets will not be reconstructed at this time due to the complexity of the Kirkwood project.

**Will I/customers be able to get to my business?** Yes but with limited access. During the first couple of weeks minor utility work will be done that is necessary before the roadwork is started. However when the pavement excavation work is taking place – the roadway will have to be closed to all traffic. Subsoil conditions are very poor and will not accommodate traffic during construction. Kirkwood will be closed off at Morris on the north end and Grange on the south end. Residents and businesses will have to access their homes via the side streets and alleys. Driveway or alley aprons on Kirkwood Avenue will be closed during the construction process. Packard Avenue and Swift Avenue is only one block away and will be used as the primary north and southbound detour routes during construction.

**Where can customers' park?** There will be no parking along Kirkwood during the construction period. Kirkwood will be a fully closed to vehicular traffic and "NO PARKING" will be allowed within the closure area. Customers will need to park on adjacent side streets in areas without posted "No Parking" signs.

**How will I be able to get deliveries?** If you are unable to get deliveries through an alley access behind your building or via the side streets, you will need to discuss delivery issues with the contractor and on-site Engineering Department inspectors.

**What if I am handicap and need direct access?** Please notify City staff if you have a special need for access. We will be as accommodating as possible with any issues brought to our attention.

**Will my mail and packages be delivered?** Typically the US Postal service works around construction; however, if the Post Master believes that the conditions are too difficult for their postal employees, they will not deliver the mail. The same may be true for other parcel delivery companies. Therefore it may be best to discuss your options with the Post Office and other delivery companies to assure you get your mail and parcels. **Will my use of water or sewer be interrupted?** No. Sewer and water service to your building should not be interrupted.

**How long will the construction last?** The City has not yet had the pre-construction meeting with the Contractor and as a result, a schedule has not yet been submitted. This information will not be known until mid April and businesses and homeowners will be notified of the start dates.

**How much will I be special assessed?** Assessment information will be available on March 28<sup>th</sup> at the information meeting.
