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Construction Update Sidewalk Replacement Project

This letter is being sent to all businesses, residents and property owners affected by this year's hazardous sidewalk replacement project. Last January you received a letter regarding a sidewalk project that was to take place this summer. The project is very large and includes sidewalk replacement in an area bounded by College Avenue on the south, Lunham Avenue on the north, the lake on the east, and Swift Avenue on the west side. The City awarded the contract to Snorek Construction. Snorek Construction has been working all summer and completed work south of Layton however; the City has requested the contractor to delay the remainder of the work north of Layton until 2017. There are a few reasons why the City requested this of the contractor; one involves safety. Although excavations are barricaded it becomes difficult to see the extent of the excavation due to leaves dropping. Leaves filling holes can be severe hazards to pedestrians and property owners. The second reason is that concrete placed after October 1st does not have sufficient time to cure before the winter salt season. Salt is very damaging to new concrete. Therefore to protect the public and the public's investment, the City has requested the contractor to finish the work in 2017.

It is difficult to provide an exact time when the contractor will begin his work next spring but we hope to get sufficient notice out to you when that work is scheduled to begin. Invoices for 2017 work will be sent to property owners next year following completion of the work.
