1. Discussion and necessary action regarding request of resident Paul Kolodzek to re-plate the crosswalk on both west and east sides of Robert Avenue across Ramsey with the wide white sections going across and to add two "Slow-Pedestrian Crossing" signs one for eastbound traffic and one for westbound traffic on Ramsey Avenue. **MOTION BY SATTERFIELD, SECOND BY PECK** to add two "Slow-Pedestrian Crossing" signs, one for eastbound traffic and one for westbound traffic on Ramsey Avenue at Robert Avenue. Motion carried unanimously.
2. Discussion and necessary action regarding request of Alderperson Hollenbeck to raise the speed limit on Packard Avenue from College to Wanda from 25 MPH to 30 MPH. **MOTION BY SATTERFIELD, SECOND BY PECK** to increase speed limit on Packard Avenue from College to Ramsey from 25 MPH to 30 MPH. Motion carried unanimously.
