City of Cudahy Road Salt Storage Facility
PROJECT # 2019-07

OWNER/TIME: The City of Cudahy is soliciting proposals for the design & construction of a storage facility for its road salt. Sealed proposals will be received by the City of Cudahy, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, until **Friday, March 1, 2019 @ 10:00 a.m.** at the City of Cudahy, City Hall, 5050 So. Lake Drive, P. O. Box 100510, Cudahy, Wisconsin 53110. Proposals will be publicly opened and reviewed to determine if they meet minimum proposal requirements, however, a more detail evaluation will occur following the opening of all proposals. Each proposal must be submitted on the bid/proposal form provided in the Contract Documents and shall be enclosed in a sealed envelope addressed to the City of Cudahy and marked "Proposal" with the project name.

The project consists of the design & construction of a gambrel or gable style permanent road salt storage facility with a capacity to hold between 1,650 to 1800 tons of salt. The site for the storage facility has been prepared.

Contract Documents are available starting Friday, February 15, 2019. The Contract Documents are available as a download once the contractor registers with the City Engineering Department at (414) 769-2212 (office hours are Monday thru Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.). The contractor may also pick-up a paper copy of the Contract Document from the City of Cudahy Engineering Department at 5050 S. Lake Dr., Cudahy, WI.. A fee of \$10.00 per paper set will required to be prepaid if they are to be mailed to the Contractor. All bidders shall bid in accordance with, and shall bid upon the forms provided.

STATUTORY PROVISIONS: The contract letting shall be subject to the provisions of the Wisconsin Statutes, including Sections 62.15, 66.09, 779.14 and 779.16.

BID GUARANTEE: No bid will be received unless a certified check or bank draft payable to the City of Cudahy, or a satisfactory bid bond in an amount no less than five percent (5%) of the bid, shall accompany each bid as a guarantee that if the bid is accepted, the bidder will execute and file the Agreement and a 100% performance bond and payment bond, within ten (10) days after the Notice of Award. In case the bidder fails to file such contract and bond within the time set forth, the check or bid bond shall be forfeited to the City of Cudahy as liquidated damages.

BID WITHDRAWAL: No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) days after the bid opening date without the consent of the City of Cudahy.

BID REJECTION: The City of Cudahy reserves the right to accept any bid most advantageous to the City, waive any technicality or reject any or all bids.
