The Cudahy Police Department as of October 20, 2014, has billed Chronic Nuisance properties in the amount of \$31,087.83 in violations under the Chronic Nuisance Ordinance during this year. In the most recent billing last week, four properties were billed \$8,031.36 for services rendered by the Cudahy Police Department under the Chronic Nuisance Ordinance.

The billings performed provide reimbursement for Municipal Police Services from a property owner identified with Chronic Nuisance Activities. Under our city's Chronic Nuisance Ordinance, the Common Council no longer has to hold a review reimbursement hearing and these property owners are billed for these activities for their properties with identified incidents.

"Your elected officials continue to stand committed to enforcement and action regarding these properties, taking the undue burden away from the taxpayers of the City of Cudahy," stated Mayor John Hohenfeldt. "I want to assure our citizens that the Mayor, Common Council, Cudahy Police Department and all Municipal Departments stand committed to enforcement and action regarding chronic nuisance properties located here in our city."
