

REGULAR MEETING  
CUDAHY POLICE AND FIRE COMMISSION  
April 10, 2014

President Thomas Kujawa called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. in Conference Room A of the Cudahy City Hall, Cudahy, Wisconsin. Commissioners Thomas Kujawa, Kathryn Wojtysiak, Victor Venus, Gerald Rieder and Donald Mulock were present. Chief of Police Thomas Poellot, Fire Chief Daniel Mayer and Recording Secretary Jaci Duvall were also present.

President Kujawa read the open meeting law statement.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mulock and seconded by Commissioner Venus to accept the minutes of the Regular Meeting March 13, 2014, as typewritten. All Commissioners voted in favor. Motion carried.

**FIRE DEPARTMENT**

Chief Mayer presented the Fire Department report for March 2014. The month of March was devoted to completing EMT recertification, SCBA (Self Contained Breathing Apparatus) Evolutions, Haz-Mat Refresher, EMS and emergencies involving helmet removal training. Chief Mayer pointed out the importance of helmet removal training as it relates to motorcycle helmets. Haz-Mat Refresher training included odors that emanate from furnace malfunctions, heat exchanges and sewers.

**POLICE DEPARTMENT**

Chief Poellot talked about a block of in-service ALICE (Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Conquer, Evacuate) training that School Resources Officers (SRO) Steve Kaminski and Mike Strzok conducted for teachers and administrators. The SROs provided an opportunity for discussion of what to do when the physical safety of a teacher and students are at risk.

**OLD BUSINESS**

Interview questions for both Police Officer and Firefighter-EMT candidates were reviewed.

Interview dates were set. – Police Officer interviews will be scheduled for Saturday, May 3. Firefighter-EMT interviews will be scheduled for Sunday, May 4.

Chief Poellot was excused at 6:21 p.m.

At 6:22 p.m., Commissioner Venus made a motion to enter into closed session according to State Statute 19.85(1)(c) Personnel Matter – Fire Department Completion of Probationary Period/Approval of Appointment – Firefighter-EMT Josh McCown (5/13/14).
