

REGULAR MEETING  
CUDAHY POLICE AND FIRE COMMISSION  
January 10, 2012

President Thomas Kujawa called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m., in Conference Room A of the Cudahy City Hall, Cudahy, Wisconsin. Commissioners Thomas Kujawa, Kathryn Wojtysiak, Raymond Glowacki, Gerald Rieder and Victor Venus were present. Also present for the meeting were Fire Chief Daniel Mayer, Chief of Police Thomas Poellot and Recording Secretary Jaci Duvall.

President Kujawa read the open meeting law statement.

A motion was made by Commissioner Glowacki and seconded by Commissioner Venus to accept the minutes of the Regular Meeting on December 13<sup>th</sup> and the Special Meeting on December 21, 2011, as typewritten. All Commissioners voted in favor. Motion carried.

**FIRE DEPARTMENT**

Chief Mayer stated that most of the November training was devoted to a State mandated EMT refresher course, which occurs every two years. The State certified EMT program includes testing and licensing.

The Fire Department December 2011 Report was held over for next month's meeting.

Battalion Chief's promotion process was reviewed. Chief Mayer will post for the vacancy later this week and forward the timeline to the Commission.

**OLD BUSINESS**

Fire Fighter applications are available on the City's website and at both Fire Stations. Information has been forwarded to state technical schools and all Fire Departments within the State by Chief Mayer.

Chief Mayer was excused at 6:10 p.m.

**POLICE DEPARTMENT**

Chief Poellot informed the Commission of two grants that the Police Department received for Click It or Ticket and Speed Enforcement totaling \$50,000 for overtime and another \$10,000 grant for OWI enforcement.

Progress was shared with the Commission in the development of the Chief's panel interview in the Sergeant's promotion process, which will include a system for evaluating items such as past performance, special assignments, outstanding contributions, etc.

**ADJOURNMENT**

Commissioner Glowacki made a motion to adjourn; Commissioner Wojtysiak seconded the motion. All Commissioners voted in favor, motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 6:30 p.m.
