ROLL CALL

The Meeting was called to order by Ald Mikolajczak at 5:30 P.M. with the following answering “present” to roll call: Ald Mikolajczak, Ald Bartoshevich, Willie Lohr, Mike Clark & Jack Puetz

Also Present: DPW Director Mary Jo Lange

Proper open meeting statement was made at this time.

Motion made by Lohr, seconded by Bartoshevich to approve the Minutes of the March 26, 2012 meeting. All voted in favor with the exception of Mike Clark & Jack Puetz who were not present at the March meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

1. **Discussion & Approval of policy to charge “hardship garbage cases” the normal fee for special pick-up requests.** Lange stated that there was a request made to continue yard waste pick-up free of charge to individuals on the garbage hardship list. There are about 18 people. The City sent a letter stating that they were no longer continuing this service. Lange stated that the department is trying to look for ways to reduce costs and run efficiently. Lange stated the these requests take a crew away from other more critical tasks. Lange also informed the Board that all of the people on the hardship list are having this work done by a contractor or other. There is no ordinance or policy that allows free yard waste pick-up. Motion made by Lohr seconded by Puetz to continue to provide garbage pick-up but not yard waste. Further, motion made that Attorney Eberhardy be contacted to revise the ordinance to make it clearer. All voted in favor.
