

**MINUTES OF THE CITY OF CUDAHY TRAFFIC AND SAFETY COMMISSION

ROLL CALL

Meeting called to order at 6:00 PM by Ald Bartoshevich with the following answering present to roll call: Ald Bartoshevich, Carl Hepp, Ken Peck, Don Jensen, Bill Mani and Frank Stanaszek. Director DPW Lange and Sgt. Kitzrow were also in attendance.

OPEN MEETING STATEMENT

The proper open meeting statement was read.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Discussion and appropriate action regarding need for 4 way stop at the intersection of E. Plankinton and S. Kirkwood Avenues. Discussion ensued. DPW Director Lange stated that stop signs cannot be put out there randomly without a police department study. Controlling speed is not the proper use of a stop sign and stop signs that are not warranted are more of a danger to the public because traffic is likely to run the stop sign. She noted that there is increased traffic due to Packard Avenue construction and noted that the intersection of Packard and Layton reopening by Tuesday. Director Lange did not advise to erect a four way stop without proper evaluation and that it probably did not warrant the four way stop. Further discussion ensued and public comment took place at this time. **MOTION BY ALD. BARTOSHEVICH, SECOND BY DON JENSEN** to request further study by the Police Department and Engineering department. Motion carried.

2. Discussion and appropriate action regarding removal of “No Parking” signs on North side of Ramsey Avenue in front of Jones School and replacing them with “No Parking – Pick-Up/Drop-Off Zone 12AM – 4PM School Days”. This is a recommendation by the Engineering and Police Department. **MOTION BY FRANK STANASZEK, SECOND BY DONALD JENSEN** to approve. Motion carried.
