For Immediate Release: City of Cudahy Plan Commission and Design Review Board approve Patrick Cudahy facility expansion plans.

At a Special Meeting of the City of Cudahy Plan Commission and Design Review Board held on Monday October 27, 2014 at 7 p.m., the Plan Commission and Design Review Board approved an expansion plan for their facility located in Cudahy Wisconsin at One Sweet Applewood Lane. The Plans submitted were approved by the governing bodies.

The addition to the Cudahy facility is a 17,000 square foot addition with an estimated value of \$12 million dollars. The time period for construction of the building is about a 25 week time period, weather dependent. Patrick Cudahy anticipates production beginning in this addition by October 2015. The building addition was designed for Patrick Cudahy by Epstein, an Architecture Interior Engineering and Construction firm.

In early October, representatives of Patrick Cudahy approached the City of Cudahy with a very aggressive time schedule for the project. Through two meetings of Administrative Staff Review during the month of October, the plans were able to be brought forward on this project in less than one month.

“This continued commitment to our community by Patrick Cudahy will allow them to expand their facility, increase efficiencies, and sustain jobs in Cudahy,” stated Mayor John Hohenfeldt. Patrick Cudahy is anticipating breaking ground this fall on the project.
