
There are several things you can do to help insure a smooth and safe transition to and from school:

- Follow all posted signs. They have been put in place to assist in a smooth transition to and from school.
- Pull up to the first open spot. At CHS it may be the bus loading zone; keep in mind buses have first priority.
- Follow all traffic and safety rules around school zones.

Your child's safety is of utmost importance to us. Please help us make sure that everyone gets to school and home safely.
